Where hope and healing begin

After years in a methadone treatment program, my body, mind, and spirit were beaten down. My life was on a downward spiral, which ended when I woke up last year in a psychiatric unit, with the realization that I had lost everything. That was rock bottom — but what happened after that was nothing short of a miracle. I was led to Frederick Rescue Mission's Faith House, where I found everything I needed to leave my past behind and embrace life. A "wall of women" surrounded me — my case manager, legal advocate, mentor, counselor, and others in recovery. They give me hope for my future every day. I didn't even know hope existed before Faith House, but now I understand the kind of love that transforms — and I will never be the same.

When people ask me what my life was like before the Mission's Changed Life Recovery Program, only one word comes to mind: miserable. In fact, it was worse than miserable — it was non-existent. My addiction was alcoholism, so drinking was the only way I knew how to survive. In 2017, I hit rock bottom. I applied to the CLRP program — and that's where I reclaimed my life. During that year, I learned that no one recovers alone. We need a strong spiritual base and we need each other. I accepted help and, one day at a time, things began to change. I've been sober for over two years now. I have a good job and my own place. I'm grateful for my new life every day.
